The two had been arguing and he wanted to distance himself from her so he went downstairs to be alone. He stated he had been drinking and she took his beer away from him and a verbal argument ensued. He stated at some point the female elbowed him and began hitting him before she took some of his property from the bedroom to the living room. He stated she was hitting him the entire time and he was pushing her away in self defense. He stated that he placed his hands on her neck but only to push her away. At some point in the bedroom he stated he pulled out the firearm, asked her to leave again, and then put it away.	
	Neither of the involved parties had any visible injuries or complaints of pain. The male was transported to St Vincent for treatment and the female collected some of her belongings from the home and left with her friends.
