For over 13 years, the Evansville Police Department has been hosting the Basic Police Motorcycle Operators Course. Focusing on various practical exercises that stress low-speed maneuverability, evasion techniques, and high-speed braking skills. Students of our program spend a large portion of the course in the saddle. They are given practical exercises and riding instruction supplemented with classroom instruction and demonstrations of tactical techniques.

INSTRUCTOR:

Josh Proctor has been a police officer since 2004, and has been with the Evansville Police Department since 2009. In 2007, Officer Proctor completed the Northwestern Basic Police Motorcycle Officer School. In 2019, he completed the Evansville Police Department Basic Motorcycle Officer School, under the direction supervision of Officer Randy Matthews, who retired in 2019. Officer Proctor then graduated from the Police Motorcycle Officer Instructor School (IPTM) in Deland, Florida. He is currently assigned to the Evansville Police Department Traffic Enforcement Unit.
