Both parents stated they have kept that individual away from the child. The mother declined the recommendation and did not inform the father or child services, despite a court order requiring both parents to share medical information. During the conversation, the juvenile again stated that they would commit suicide if required to go to the fathers residence. Due to the juveniles suicidal statements, previous mental health concerns, and the mothers failure to follow treatment recommendations, officers determined the juvenile was in crisis and in need of Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) emergency detention. The juvenile was transported to the hospital for evaluation.
